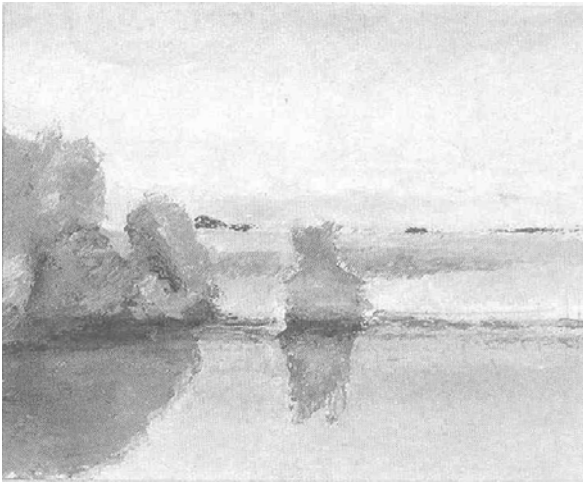

## Art show explores essence of color



The Davis Community Gallery will open its third and final show of the year – “Color of Light, Color of Shadow,” featuring local plein air landscapes and still life oil paintings by Ann Rea -- with a reception for the artist from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Friday.

The public is welcome, and refreshments will be served.

The gallery is located in the waiting room and the community room of the Davis Community Clinic, 2040 Sutter Place, Davis.

Rea uses painting as a form of meditation and a source of tranquility. She feels strongly about using a full spectrum of pure oil pigments to represent light, and states, “I never use black. It represents the absence of color and light.”

In her works, she explores form through the essence of color, and discovers how color vibrates, the way from bends it, and how color radiates...even in shadows.

Rea’s art is for sale, and percentage of the proceeds will be donated to CommuniCare Health Centers.
